The Association

Faculty Association Ibn Battuta has a welcoming atmosphere and an innovative attitude. To owe up to these characteristics, we will provide opportunities to join Ibn Battuta through new activities and initiatives. These aim to reconnect the community and offer possibilities for interaction and inclusion of members regardless of their year of study. Additionally, we give members more occasions to network with alumni of the Faculty of Spatial Sciences to strengthen their interconnectedness.

Projectgroup Dies

To recognize the Dies Natalis of the Association, a Projectgroup Dies will be appointed. They will organize a Dies Day to celebrate the birthday of the Association with members and friends. The spectacular celebration will consist of multiple activities throughout the day.

Introduction Period

Ibn Battuta will offer multiple occasions for students to get to know the Association and each other in the first two weeks of the Academic Year. Additionally, we focus on reintegrating all members during the Introduction Period due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Therefore, Projectgroup Introduction Period provides introductory activities for first-year students, as well as older students.

Introduction Day Bachelor Students

The afternoon planning of the Introduction Day will be adapted to give first-year students a better impression of what Ibn Battuta has to offer. The City Tour will be shortened and a social afternoon activity will be hosted by Projectgroup Introduction Period. Besides first-year students, all members are also welcome at the afternoon activity to increase interaction.

Introduction Day (Pre-)Master Students

A separate Introduction Day will be organized for (pre-)master students. This day is organized by a task force consisting of members from different Faculty bodies. The program will begin with an introduction to the Faculty of Spatial Sciences and the Zernike Campus for new (pre-)master students. Afterward, all incoming (pre-)master students are welcome at an interactive event to introduce the students to each other.

Committee Plaza

A Committee Plaza will be organized in Groningen, which provides students with a more in-depth view of what committees have to offer. This is in addition to a casual introduction of committees on Ameland. The Committee Plaza takes place twice a year: once during the Introduction Period for the committees opening in September and once for the committees opening in February and May.

Career Orientation Symposium

A Career Orientation Symposium will be organized to encourage young professional development and introduce members to potential working fields. Workshops on professional competencies are offered to facilitate professional development, while introductory lectures will give insight into potential working fields. This Symposium is organized by the Lecture Committee to diversify their repertoire.

Sustainability and Society Committee

We will turn Projectgroup Sustainability and Society into a committee due to the continued interest and long-term relevance. The Sustainability and Society Committee will establish a sustainability roadmap for the Association. Furthermore, they will increase societal awareness and participation within Ibn Battuta by collaborating with a charity organization. This provides members with opportunities to give back to society.

Professor Keuning Vereniging

Ibn Battuta will proactively reach out to the Professor Keuning Vereniging to link alumni to members. Therefore, alumni are invited to selected events of Ibn Battuta. This will facilitate connections of members to the field of spatial sciences and strengthen the community of alumni.

Study Room

During the exam period, Ibn Battuta arranges a study room for members on Zernike Campus. This provides members with the opportunity to study collaboratively. Additionally, committees can request a room through the board.
